



2018-19 University of California Global Food Initiative Fellowship

UC Agriculture and Natural Resources is seeking outstanding students to apply for the 2018-19 Global Food Initiative Fellowship in Communications/Outreach. **The application deadline is Monday, May 21, 2018.**

About the UC GFI Fellowship

The UC Global Food Initiative Student Fellowship Program funds student-generated research, related projects or internships that focus on food issues. All 10 UC campuses plus UC Agriculture and Natural Resources (UC ANR) and Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory participate in the program.

The Fellow will receive a \$4,000 stipend, paid half at the beginning and half at the end of the Fellowship. (Applicants should be aware that receipt of a fellowship may affect your financial aid package; please contact your financial aid officer with any questions.)

The **UC ANR GFI Fellowship in Communications/Outreach** focuses on community outreach and education, specifically:

- Educating the public through written, visual, and online communications about nutrition policy, food security, federal food programs, food waste reuse, childhood obesity prevention and other nutrition and food policy issues.
- Educating the public through written, visual, and online communications about UC ANR's impact on the above topics.

The UC ANR GFI Fellow will write one-pagers, blog posts, social media posts, news articles and other communications about nutrition and food policy issues. The Fellow will also assist in the development of communication plans and outreach implementation plans.

The Fellow is expected to work on the project for an average of five to ten hours per week throughout the 2018-19 academic year and is also expected to attend all systemwide activities for the GFI Fellowship program, which begin with an orientation on July 9, 2018 at UC Santa Barbara. Other systemwide activities include a spring field trip and a closing symposium and poster presentation to be held in conjunction with the CA Higher Education Sustainability Conference (CHESC) in June/July 2019. Systemwide activities are funded by the UC Global Food Initiative above and beyond the fellowship award.



How to Apply

To apply for the UC ANR GFI Fellowship in Communications/Outreach, submit the following items by email to easizensky@ucanr.edu by May 21, 2018:

1. Cover letter stating your interest in this fellowship and a summary of your most relevant experience, skills and/or education.
2. Resume.
3. 1 to 3 examples of your previous communications work.

Qualifications

- Experience in writing, graphic design, video or radio/podcasts
- Knowledgeable about food and nutrition topics
- Able to work independently as well as part of a group

Selection and Notification

Select applicants will be asked to participate in a half-hour in-person interview between May 22 – May 29, 2018. Applicants will be notified of the decision by June 4, 2018.
